Community Service

- Neonate at risk or diagnosed with Infant Feeding Disorders
- Faltering growth < 1 year
- Faltering growth > 1 year old with 2 members of CCH MDT involved
- Medically / surgically fragile children with increased nutritional requirements
- Paediatric Feeding Disorders with 2 members of MDT involved
- Enteral Tube feeding

Outpatient Clinic

- Allergies (priority for anaphylaxis).
- Food protein induced enterocolitis syndrome (FPIES)
- Coeliac disease
- Faltering growth > 1 year old
- Paediatric Feeding Disorders / ARFID with Autism Spectrum Disorder diagnosis
- Diagnosed vitamin or mineral deficiency
- Constipation with associated nutritional issues
- Obesity with co morbidity and referral made to Active Families (Harbour Sport or Sport Waitakere)
