Where do I go for my appointment?

YSS reception is on the 3rd floor of the Savoy Building. The reception desk and waiting room is located straight through the main doors. Please let the reception staff know you've arrived. Reception is open Monday - Friday 8.30am - 5.00pm.

How can I get there?

There is a local bus service, run by Otago Regional Council. The nearest bus stop is just around the corner from Moray Place on Princes Street – see map.

For parking there is a Wilsons Parking Building just up the road on Moray Place, and also pay and display parks along Moray Place and View Street – see map.

Where can I get something to eat and drink?

The nearest café is just across the road from YSS. There are many other food outlets nearby in Moray Place and around the corner along Princes Street to the Octagon. The nearest supermarkets are in Cumberland Street and Great King Street.

Where can I go for a smoke?

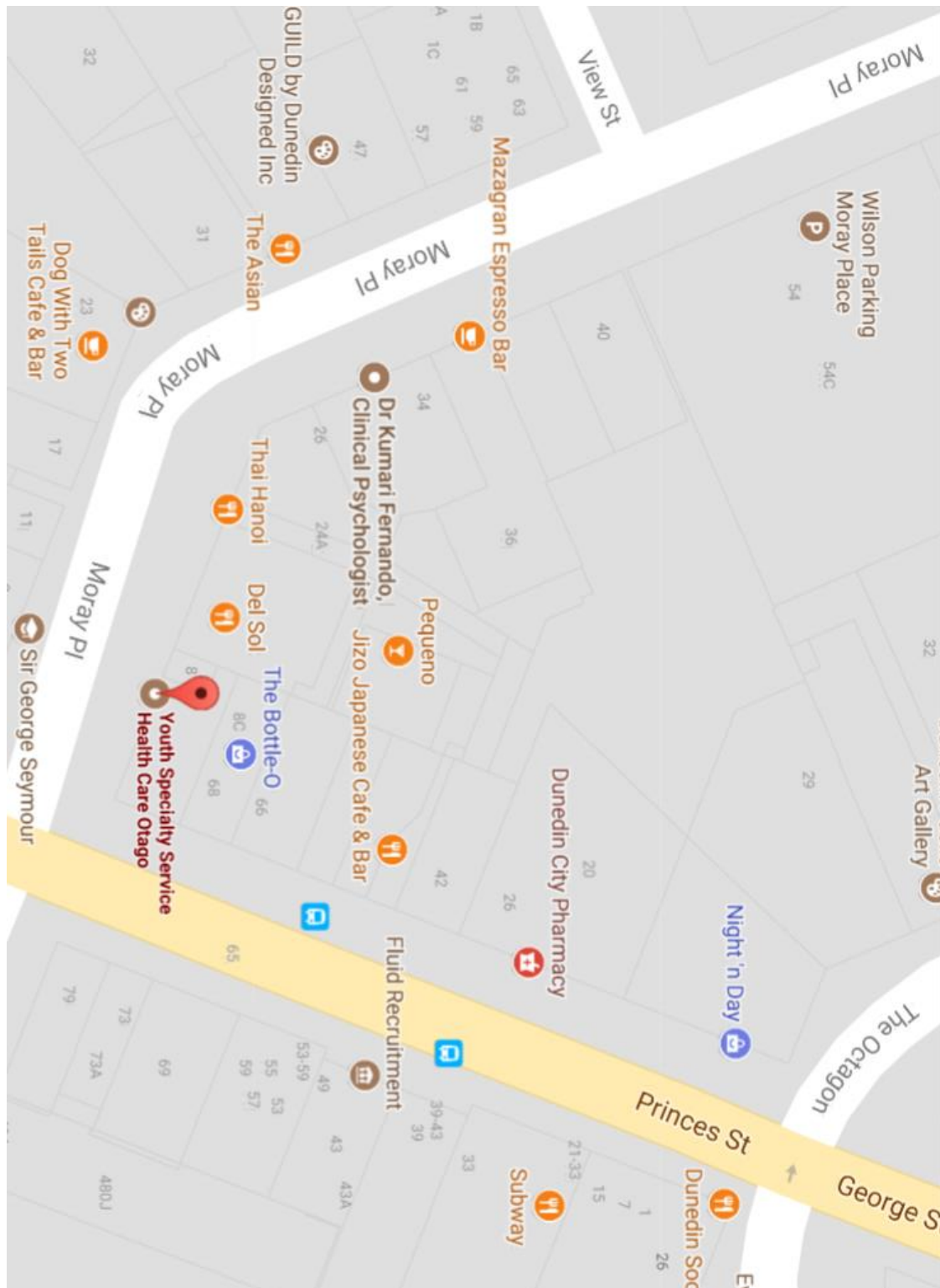
YSS is a non-smoking area. We encourage visitors and patients who smoke or vape to do so off-site.
