





Personal Health Orthotic Service and Product Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What's happening with our Personal Health Orthotic Services and Products?

Auckland, Counties Manukau and Waitemata DHB's went to market for Personal Health Orthotic Services and Products in March 2021. Following an official procurement process in July 2021 we:

- a. Developed direct supply relationships with manufacturers and distributors for the provision of the majority off-the-shelf orthotic products.
- b. Appointed Peke Waihanga as the provider of Personal Health Orthotic Services; and

2. What are we doing with orthotic products and how do I order them?

The DHBs are aiming to directly order from manufacturers and distributors 90-95% of all off-the-shelf orthotic products.

3. What direction are the DHBs moving for Person Health Orthotic Services?

The Peke Waihanga Orthotist can be utilised if:

- Complicated fitting/product/measuring/assessment needed
- Clinician unable to fit product themselves
- We don't have the product

The goal is for Peke Waihanga Orthotists to be providing services for more complicated assessments, fittings or product requests including custom made products where necessary.

Peke Waihanga will prioritise referrals according to the Ministry of Health Tier 2 Orthotic Service Specification.
