## **Instructions to Patients**

A GASTROSCOPY is an examination of the oesophagus, stomach and duodenum for diagnosis and treatment of gastric problems. This involves swallowing a flexible tube. It is important that the stomach must be completely empty for this examination.

• Please do NOT eat or drink for at least 6 hours prior to your appointment at Mercy Endoscopy

A COLONOSCOPY is an examination of the bowel by means of a narrow flexible tube for diagnosis and treatment of bowel conditions. The bowel must be completely empty for this examination.

· Instructions for bowel preparation will be given when you contact Mercy Endoscopy for an appointment.

AN ERCP is an examination of the pancreas and bile duct. This involves swallowing a flexible tube and an X-ray procedure.

A BRONCHOSCOPY is an examination of the bronchial tubes to the lungs by means of a flexible tube for diagnosis and treatment of lung conditions.

- Because a sedative is likely to be used do NOT drive a motor vehicle for at least 12 hours following the examination.
- Please arrange for someone to collect you after the examination.
- Please bring all the medications that you are currently taking, your X-rays, and this request form with you.
- · If you are a diabetic, are taking aspirin or 'blood thinning drugs' or have a significant medical condition, inform the Endoscopy staff at the time of booking as special instructions may apply.
