Breastfeeding Support in South Auckland



It can take time to learn how to breastfeed. It is important to get the support you need where, and when you need it. If you had your baby at the hospital or a birthing unit, you may have been visited by a breastfeeding advocate or a lactation consultant. Lactation consultants specialise in supporting people with breastfeeding challenges. As well as whaanau, there are free community breastfeeding services available in South Auckland to support you.

Your midwife

Your midwife can support you while you are pregnant and for up to six weeks after your baby is born. Your midwife will visit you at home within 24 hours after you leave the hospital or birthing unit. If you want help with baby's feeding when you are at home, contact your midwife.

If your midwife is not available, you are welcome to phone the birthing unit in your area for help.

Te Rito Ora

Te Rito Ora is a free community service that provides breastfeeding and baby feeding support for up to two years. The team of skilled workers will:

- support you to prepare for breastfeeding
- provide infant feeding advice after your baby is born

A lactation consultant is available if you have more complex breastfeeding needs.

Te Rito Ora can provide support by phone, text, email, video calling, home visits, Facebook and online.

B4Baby Breastfeeding Service give free kaupapa Maaori breastfeeding education and support for whaanau for up to six months after your baby is born. B4Baby offers:

- breastfeeding education before birth
- breastfeeding advocates (kaiawhina) who can visit you at home
- lactation consultant support

You can also ask to be seen at the Coveney Clinic at Turuki Healthcare, 2/32 Canning Crescent, Mangere.
