## SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

Te Ohu Whakaaraara (TOW) work alongside whānau to identify their dreams and aspirations using Te Ara Whānau Ora (TAWO). TAWO is an engagement process recognising the mana of whānau, who are the experts and co-designers of their ngā moemoea.



Kāinga Whānau Ora (KWO) supports whānau dreams and aspirations by bringing together key agencies because we know that we can achieve better outcomes when we work together. Sometimes systems get in the way of whānau achieving their goals, we aim to stop creating 'work arounds' and create systems that work for whānau.

Ngā Tini Whetū (NTW) supports whānau with past and current engagement with Oranga Tamariki, drawing on the success of Te Ohu Whakaaraara and Kāinga Whānau Ora. We have four Kaiwhakaaraara, in four Regions and one purpose - to support whānau to raise their tamariki within their whānau, hapu, iwi.
